

LOCAL SAFETY GUIDELINES **FOR KITEBOARDING ON** **THE ESTUARY**

The Estuary foreshore is hard and hazardous, so please...

Riders going out have priority, but should be prepared to assist incoming riders if they're in difficulty.

If you can't ride up wind, launch from Sandy Point, and please don't sail beyond the blue buoy.

Stay at least 50m (2 line lengths) away from the road, or any lesson being conducted at Sandy Point.

Don't jump or loop within 50m of shore, and when it's busy signal your intentions early by voice or gesture.

Keep clear of buoys at low tide - they mark hazards.

Wear a kite leash at all times.

Please close the swing gate behind you.
