

LOCAL SAFETY GUIDELINES **FOR KITEBOARDING ON** **THE ESTUARY**

The Estuary foreshore is hard and hazardous, so please...

- Riders going out have priority, but should be prepared to assist incoming riders if they're in difficulty.
- If you can't sail up wind, walk around to Sandy Point to launch, and please don't sail beyond the blue buoy.
- Don't ride within 50m (2 line lengths) of the road, or any lesson being conducted at Sandy Point.
- Don't jump or loop within 50m of shore, and when it's busy signal your intentions early by voice or gesture.
- Keep clear of buoys at low tide - they mark hazards.
- Wear a kite leash at all times.
